

9 WAYS TO DISPLAY ART



On a bookshelf

You can display art on any bookshelf, combining them with book spines and other decorative objects. You can also layer them to add depth.







A Stair-Step Gallery (below)

This is another cool way for displaying your art. However, it could be a bit difficult to measure. By having different-sized frames, you can create a less angular look.

Small Ledge (above)

You can add a small art ledge on your wall, and add your art piece on top. If the ledge is wide enough, you can also add some extra elements to tie the whole look together.



1 Row of frames

This way of displaying art can be used on the walls of a long hallway. It's always best to use identical frames. You can also use this style on the wall above your sofa in your living room.





Grid of frames

You can line your art up by creating a symmetric grid. Depending on the size of your wall, you can opt for a different number of pieces.

Gallery Wall

This style is similar to the grid of frames. The main difference is that, in this case, it's cooler if all your frames are different sizes. This creates more dimension and a bolder look.




Hang or lean above your fireplace

The mantel over your home's fireplace is also a great spot for displaying your art pieces. You can also mix it up by adding some decorative objects around them. You can either hang it or lean it on the mantel.

Floor-to-Ceiling Installation (below)

Bedroom walls are a great place to create floor-to-ceiling collages. You can pair art pieces with other elements like family photos.

Stack Vertically (above)

This style is perfect for narrow areas. You can hang your art pieces vertically between windows or on a small wall.
